- We are excited to share that this year's turnout is looking very strong. If you are planning to join in this year's fun, please make your reservations now at either the Clarion Hotel [\$40 a night] phone (866) 246-2021 or (502) 491-4830, or the Holiday Inn [\$43 a night] phone (502) 426-2600.
- The Holiday Inn is located at the same freeway exit as the Clarion Hotel, although on the other side of the Interstate. They have free shuttle vans to transport us between the two properties.
- If you are flying to Louisville and would like to be picked up by the free Clarion or Holiday Inn shuttles, please call them with your flight arrangements before travel.
- The Clarion will be servicing with "light housekeeping" duties only—meaning fresh towels each day and trash removal. If you need additional soap or toilet paper, all you have to do is ask housekeeping.

- **PLEASE NOTE:** The deadline for the **Young Adult Dinner/Dance registration** and **pre-WFW registration** is **December 15**. After this date all registration to the Young Adult Dance is closed and the sports registration will be at the higher prices mentioned above, so please take advantage of the lower prices right away.
