FATAH MILITANTS MULL RESUMING TERROR AGAINST ISRAEL

November 3, 2016 Breitbart.com reported: "The commanders of Al Aqsa Martyrs Brigades, Fatah's military wing, have been mulling the possibility of turning their guns against Israel and the Palestinian Authority's 'despots,' a top Brigade militant told Breitbart Jerusalem.

The militant said that since the end of the second intifada, and the amnesty agreement that was reached with Israel shortly after Hamas' takeover of the Gaza Strip in 2007, 'the occupation only deepened, and corruption in the PA only widened. The people are desperate for a game change that would turn the tables and bring the Palestinian question back to the top of the agenda.'..."

CENTURIES BEFORE TRYING TO DENY IT, MUSLIMS CARVED JEWISH LINK TO JERUSALEM INTO MOSQUE

November 2, 2016 thetimesofisrael.com reported: "A recently studied inscription from a mosque near Hebron offers insight into how, until the mid-20th century, the Muslim world considered Jerusalem's Dome of the Rock to be the successor to two ancient Jewish shrines that formerly stood atop the Temple Mount.

The previously overlooked dedicatory inscription from the Mosque of Umar in Nuba, a village nearly 26 kilometers (16 miles) southwest of Jerusalem, mentions the village as an endowment for the Dome of the Rock and Al-Aqsa Mosque. But what's striking is that the Dome of the Rock is referred to in the text as 'the rock of the Bayt al-Maqdis' — literally, 'The Holy Temple' — a verbatim translation of the Hebrew term for the Jerusalem temple that early Muslims employed to refer to Jerusalem as a whole, and the gold-domed shrine in particular.

Local tradition ascribed the construction of the mosque to Caliph Umar ibn al-Khattab, under whose rule Arab armies conquered Jerusalem and the rest of Byzantine Palestine in the mid-7th century. It was under his eventual successor Abd al-Malik, the fifth caliph, that the Dome of the Rock was completed in 691 CE..."



WAR ON THE STREETS OF PARIS: ARMED MIGRANTS FIGHT RUNNING BATTLES IN THE FRENCH CAPITAL

November 2, 2016 express.co.uk reported: "The area around Stalingrad Metro station was turned into a refugee battleground as rival gangs of migrants set upon each other in shocking scenes of violence. Asylum seekers wearing hooded tops wielded makeshift clubs fashioned from lengths of wood which they used to bludgeon each other as horrified pedestrians looked on.

The blood-curdling brawl erupted just yards from the Stalingrad Metro station, where a squalid migrant camp has popped up following the demolition of the Jungle. It was not immediately clear what sparked the early morning fight, but rival gangs of people smugglers have previously been involved in violent brawls in Calais.

And despite the horrific brawl, a pro-migrant rally is apparently being organised to take place at the camp at 6pm tonight. The once peaceful neighbourhood, in Paris' 10th Arrondissement, used to be a popular area with tourists, boasting a lively nightlife scene bustling with restaurants and bars. But worried residents have revealed how it has become a no go zone in recent weeks following the establishment of the refugee camp, which has brought squalor and violence.

Thousands of migrants – mostly from Sudan, Libya, Afghanistan, and Eritrea – have pitched tents under the Metro station after the demolition of the Jungle hampered their attempts to reach Britain."

French police have tried to clear the squatters numerous times, but they keep returning again.

RUSSIANS CONCERNED SYRIA MAY LEAD TO WORLD WAR 3

November 1, 2016 Arutz Sheva 7 reported: "Nearly half of Russians fear that Moscow's bombing campaign in Syria could spark World War III, a poll showed Monday.

Moscow, an ally of Syrian leader Bashar al-Assad, has been staging bombing raids in Syria since September 2015.

Forty-eight percent of Russians were concerned that 'heightened tensions in relations between Russia and the West could grow into World War III,' according to a poll conducted by independent pollster Levada Centre last week. That figure was up from 29 percent in July this year.

Moscow's air strikes have negatively affected the way Russia is perceived internationally, 32 percent said, up from 16 percent in November. Nevertheless, 52 percent of Russians said they back Moscow's air strikes, while 26 percent said they opposed them..."

SWEDEN ON THE BRINK? POLICE FORCE PUSHED TO BREAKING POINT BY VIOLENCE AMID MIGRANT INFLUX

November 1, 2016 express.co.uk reported: "SWEDEN is on the brink of becoming a lawless state as the police force is losing the battle against unprecedented levels of crime and violence amid a growing migrant crisis. The Scandinavian country is facing an existential crisis with on average three police officers handing in their resignatio"ns a day.

If the alarming trend continues, and police officers continue to resign more than 1,000 officers will have quit the service by New Years. Since the migrant crisis began last summer, Sweden has been hit by a series of brutal crimes and violent incidents.

In 2015 alone Sweden, with a population of 9.5million, received over 160,000 asylum applications and the country is expected to take as many as 190,000 refugees, or two per cent of the population, by the end of 2016.

Sex assaults, drug dealing and children carrying weapons were just some of the incidents mentioned in the report. In September, Swedish officials were forced to add another three areas to the list.

Now the Police Association have said they need at least 200 new officers to regain control in the south-east of the country. Thomas Stjernfeldt, from the region's police association, told SVT: "We are missing extremely many officers in the operational sector, right now we need 200 more officers to be added to the force to establish a reasonable working environment in the southeast of Götaland."

Götaland is one of the regions in the country that has been hit hard by the car fire attacks, which have been occurring throughout Sweden."..."

'WE ARE LOSING CONTROL OF THE STREETS' MERKEL'S GERMANY DESCENDS INTO LAWLESSNESS

November 1, 2016 express.co.uk reported: "During the first six months of 2016, migrants committed 142,500 crimes, according to the Federal Criminal Police Office. And the country has been hit by a spate of horrendous violent crime including rapes, sexual and physical assaults, stabbings, home invasions, robberies, burglaries and drug trafficking.

Adding to the country's woes is the fact that thousands of people have gone missing after travelling to the country on invitation from the country's leader. Germany took in more than 1.1million migrants in the past year and parts of the country are crippled with a lack of infrastructure. Now the true reality is hitting home ahead of next year's elections as the far right surges in the polls threatening to topple the Christian Democratic Union (CDU) leader Mrs Merkel.

According to a report by the international policy council the Gatestone Institute, local police in many parts of the country admit that they are stretched to the limit. The report states: "The rape of a ten-year-old girl in Leipzig, the largest city in Saxony, has drawn renewed attention to the spiralling levels of violent crime perpetrated by migrants in cities and towns across Germany."..."

ITALY EARTHQUAKE: 6.6-MAGNITUDE TREMOR ROCKS NATION'S CENTER

October 30, 2016 cnn.com reported: "A powerful 6.6-magnitude earthquake rocked central Italy on Sunday morning, injuring at least 20 people, in the strongest tremor to hit the country in more than three decades. The earthquake follows tremors last week and comes on the heels of a devastating quake in August, which killed nearly 300 people and flattened entire villages.

Latest developments

- The quake struck 6 kilometers (3.7 miles) north of Norcia, the US Geological Survey reported.
- Fire and rescue services said six people had been pulled from rubble in Norcia.
- There were no immediate reports of deaths -- many residents had not returned since a devastating quake in August.
- There have been about 200 aftershocks since Sunday's quake in the border area between the Marche and Umbria regions, according to National Institute for Geophysics and Vulcanology.
- Some villages are cut off, so the impact there has not been assessed, said Fabrizio Curcio, the civil protection chief.
- Some 15,000 people are without electricity, according to Curcio.
- Much of the Basilica of San Benedetto in Norcia collapsed.



Authorities are hopeful there may be no deaths since many residents in the region had already been evacuated to emergency camps and hotel rooms paid for by the government after the August quake and last week's temblors, and schools had shut down in anticipation of powerful aftershocks. Italian Prime Minister Matteo Renzi in Rome thanked rescuers and vowed to rebuild damaged villages.

"Italy has many faults, but these situations bring out the best of us," he said, adding the country would rebuild houses, churches and shops. "We will rebuild everything. We have the resources to do it."..."

NEW EARTHQUAKE ROCKS ITALY, BUILDINGS COLLAPSE BUT NO DEATHS REPORTED

October 30, 2016 Reuters.com reported: "A powerful earthquake struck Italy on Sunday in the same central regions that have been rocked by repeated tremors over the past two months, with more homes and churches brought down but no deaths reported.

The quake, which measured 6.6 according to the U.S. Geological Survey, was bigger than one on Aug. 24 that killed almost 300 people. Many people have fled the area since then, helping to avoid a new devastating death toll. With thousands already made homeless, a leading seismologist warned that the earthquakes could go on for weeks in a domino effect along the central Apennine fault system.

The latest quake was felt across much of Italy, striking at 7.40 a.m. (0640 GMT), its epicenter close to the historic Umbrian walled town of Norcia, some 100 km (60 miles) from the university city of Perugia."..."

PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY: TERRORISM IS PART OF OUR CULTURE

October 30, 2016 Arutz Sheva 7 reported: "The Palestinian Authority refuses to budge following criticism of its decision to name a school after the mastermind of the 1972 Munich Massacre, according to a report by Palestinian Media Watch.

Facing condemnation from Israeli officials, including Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu, for naming a school after Salah Khalaf, who was the head of the Black September terrorist organization which carried out the kidnapping and murder of 11 Israeli athletes at the 1972 Olympic Games in Munich.

PA official and District Governor of Tulkarem, Issam Abu Bakr, responded to the Israeli condemnation by saying that celebrating terrorists and murderers is part of Palestinian Arab culture.

"The occupation is deluded if it thinks that the Palestinian people can change its culture and forget its leaders, Martyrs Yasser Arafat, Khalil Al-Wazir (Abu Jihad), Salah Khalaf, and a great number of the fighters who sacrificed their blood for the freedom, independence, and establishment of the independent Palestinian state whose capital is Jerusalem.'..."
