Security Alert: U.S. Tells Stranded Americans in Afghanistan to Avoid Kabul Airport or 'Leave Immediately'

August 26, 2021 breitbart.com reported: "The U.S. Embassy in Afghanistan has issued a security alert advising stranded Americans to either avoid the airport in Kabul or 'leave immediately' if they are waiting at the gates.

'Because of security threats outside the gates of Kabul airport, we are advising U.S. citizens to avoid traveling to the airport and to avoid airport gates at this time unless you receive individual instructions from a U.S. government representative to do so,' the embassy announced.

'U.S. citizens who are at the Abbey Gate, East Gate, or North Gate now should leave immediately,' it added..."

Canadian Imam Urges Support for Taliban, Calls Jews, Christians 'Our Enemies'

August 26, 2021 breitbart.com reported: "Canadian Imam Younus Kathrada in a recent sermon attacked Jews and Christians as 'our enemies,' accusing them of funding a failed war against Islam while calling on fellow Canadians to support the Taliban and its efforts to impose Islamic sharia law — which includes death by stoning for adultery and homosexuality — in Afghanistan.

In his speech, which was delivered at the Muslim Youth of Victoria Islamic Center on Friday, the Islamic scholar accused Jews and Christians of attempting to spend 'mountains of gold in order to take us away from Islam,' though such attempts will ultimately fail.

'So they will spend it but don't fear, at the end of the day they are not going to win,' he said. 'Allah tells us that they will spend it, and that it will be for them a source of regret.'

Kathrada then claims that the recent U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan was a sign of the supposed prophesied failure of such attempts..."

Spacecom attains initial operational capability, commander says

August 25, 2021 spacewar.com reported: "The U.S. Space Command has reached initial operational capability and is on the path to meeting full operational capability in the near future, its commander said.

Army Gen. James H. Dickinson speaking at this week's U.S. Space Foundation's 36th Space Symposium in Colorado Springs, Colorado, said 'We were absolutely ready since day one,' he said, referring to the date it was established, Aug. 29, 2019, as the Defense Department's 11th and newest combatant command.

IOC is an inflection point for Spacecom, he said. 'United States Space Command has matured to the point where we have strategic effects.'

Now, Spacecom can expand its structural, functional and organizational gains made since its establishment. 'It's where we can credibly claim to be organized and effective for employing our enduring, no-fail supporting functions to the joint force,' he said..."

Taliban Tells Women: Stay Home Until We Train Jihadis 'How to Deal' with You

August 25, 2021 breitbart.com reported: "Taliban spokesman Zabihullah Mujahid told reporters in a press conference Tuesday that the terrorist organization is urging all women in Afghanistan to stay home for their safety, as the group has not yet taught its own terrorists 'how to deal with women.'

Mujahid emphasized safety dangers for women under Taliban rule while repeating the jihadists' promise that they would allow women to work in full-time jobs and leave the house without a *burqa*, or full-body covering – rights that the Taliban denied on a national level when it last controlled Afghanistan between 1996 and 2001.

The Taliban became the de facto government of Afghanistan on August 15 after surrounding the nation's capital, Kabul, prompting former President Ashraf Ghani to flee. It currently has no formal recognition as a legitimate government but has endeavored to place its spokesmen in front of as many cameras as possible, promising the creation of an 'inclusive' government that respects women's rights..."

Pentagon preparing to unveil and demonstrate highly classified space weapon

August 24, 2021 spacewar.com reported: "A new arms race has boosted the dispute over space weapons, with talks periodically raised about a need to extend control over weapons in orbit. Despite numerous calls to demilitarize space, leading countries continue to accuse each other of developing potentially offensive technology.

The US department of Defense is, in the near future, expected to announce and demonstrate secret space weapons to show Russia and China new anti-satellite developments, *Breaking Defense* reported, citing unnamed officials.

The presentation of the weapon was said to be first planned at the National Space Symposium scheduled for August. The declassification had been prepared over the past months, but the situation around the withdrawal of the American military from Afghanistan has reportedly resulted in adjustments to the original plan as 'all arms of the national security apparatus pointed towards Kabul.'..."

Gantz: Iran is two months away from nuclear bomb

August 24, 2021 jpost.com reported: "Tehran is two months away from nuclear weapons capacity, warned Defense Minister Benny Gantz as he called for the international community to create a new prevention plan that did not involve reviving the 2015 Iran deal.

'Iran is only two months away from acquiring the materials necessary for a nuclear weapon,' Gantz told a gathering of 60 ambassadors in Tel Aviv. He spoke just one day before Prime Minister Naftali Bennett is scheduled to present such an alternative plan to US President Joe Biden at the White House on Thursday...'

60% of adults under 40 say Jesus isn't only way to salvation; equal to Buddha, Muhammad

August 24, 2021 christianpost.com reported: "More than 60% of born again Christians in America between the ages of 18 and 39 believe that Buddha, Muhammad and Jesus are all valid paths to salvation and over 30% say they either believe that Jesus sinned just like other people when He lived on Earth or aren't sure, according to a new study.

There's a 'striking decline' in evangelical religious beliefs and practices over the last 10 years, as the number of selfproclaimed believers to hold these beliefs has increased by nearly 25%, says Probe Ministries in a statement announcing the results of its Religious Views & Practices Survey.

The study, which interviewed 3,100 Americans ages 18 to 55 in 2020 and looked at various other previous studies, saw a drop in 'basic biblical worldview' — God's attributes, the accuracy of the Bible, salvation and Jesus being sinless — from 47% in 2010 to 25% in 2020 among born again Christians..."

Afghan Christian: 'The whole world has abandoned us'

August 20, 2021 World Net Daily reported: "In an emotional appeal videoed on 'the first day of Taliban rule,' an Afghan Christian pleaded with Christians around the world not to abandon the church in Afghanistan as the nation faces the sudden loss of all of its gains over the past two decades.

'I don't know that the future of this country will be,' he said, according to a translation. 'We are not able to control our emotions, because we've worked so hard for 20 years. All of our work over the past 20 years has been lost overnight.'

The Christian man, whose voice cracked at times though his message, said the video was produced as a 'testimony.'

'We want it to be remembered by our friends and loved ones that today we have been left in the field by ourselves,' he said as 'our beautiful country ... has now been destroyed by this savage and extremist group..."

Report: Taliban Killing People Found with Bibles on Their Phones

August 19, 2021 World Net Daily reported: "The Taliban is killing people in Afghanistan they find with copies of the Bible on their mobile phones, a Christian non-profit denounced on Tuesday.

The Taliban, a radical Islamist terrorist organization, seized leadership of the country on Sunday after surrounding the nation's capital, Kabul, prompting former President Ashraf Ghani to flee. The Taliban ruled Afghanistan until 2001, when the United States invaded the country, and established a brutal regime that regularly persecuted political dissidents, religious minorities, women, and anyone considered to be violating Islamic law, or sharia.

According to SAT-7, an organization that broadcasts Christian programs to churches and Christians in the Middle East and North Africa, the Taliban is using 'spies and informants' to persecute the Christian minority in the country..."
