#### Iran warns Israel against more 'military adventures'

October 14, 2021 jpost.com reported: "Majid Takht Ravanchi, the Iranian ambassador to the UN, slammed Israel on Thursday claiming that 'over the past months, the number and intensity of Israeli regime provocative and adventurous threats has steadily increased to alarming levels.' He sent the complaint to the head of the UN Security Council, a report at Tasnim News in Iran said on Thursday.

Takht Ravanchi has slammed Israel in the past. Several weeks ago, he complained about Israeli Prime Minister Naftali Bennett's speech, claiming it was 'full of lies.' Bennett has said that Iran was trying to dominate the region. 'Iran-phobia runs rampant at the UN. The Israeli regime PM's speech was full of lies on Iran,' the Iranian said..."

## U.S. Is Facing a 'Worldview Crisis,' George Barna Says: 94 Percent Reject a Biblical Worldview

October 14, 2021 christianheadlines.com reported: "The United States is in the midst of a 'worldview crisis' that impacts every other issue facing the country today, researcher George Barna told a gathering of Christians in Leesburg, VA, on Thursday.

Barna, the senior research fellow for the Center for Biblical Worldview at the Family Research Council and the head of the Cultural Research Center at Arizona Christian University, pointed to research from this year showing that only 6 percent of American adults have a biblical worldview – even though 51 percent believe they do. The Cultural Research Center conducted the survey. Ninety-four percent of Americans don't hold to a biblical worldview.

'A lot of people are walking around America today, self-deceived, about their worldview,' he said...

The dominant worldview in America today is 'syncretism,' which involves 'picking and choosing' elements from other worldviews, Barna said. The result: Americans' worldviews often include beliefs that conflict and contradict one another. All total, 88 percent of American adults hold to syncretism, according to data from Arizona Christian University's Cultural Research Center..."

#### Taliban Education Minister: Content Contrary to Radical Sharia Law Will Be Eradicated

October 14, 2021 breitbart.com reported: "Taliban Education Minister Mullah Noorullah Munir declared last week his country's aim to replace all educational content which 'contradicts' radical Islamic sharia law or Afghan traditions, noting that music would no longer be 'compatible' with it.

Appearing on *Al-Jazeera* last Monday, Munir shared the Taliban's aim to replace all content in Afghanistan's education curricula that contradicts sharia law or Afghan traditions and customs. '[I]f we find content that contradicts sharia law in any textbook, we will have to replace it,' he said.

'Subjects such as physics, geology, chemistry, and engineering will remain intact, but if there are things that contradict sharia law, the laws of our country, or our customs and traditions, we will have no choice but to take the necessary steps,' he added. Regarding subjects such as music, Munir said they were no longer compatible..."

# Report – Israeli Officials Fear Joe Biden Iran Approach: 'The Situation Is Very Bad'

October 13, 2021 breitbart reported: "Israeli officials are increasingly concerned the Biden administration is not taking the Iranian threat seriously enough and does not have a backup plan in the case a return to the 2015 nuclear deal collapses entirely, a senior Israeli official told *Al Monitor*. The anonymous official told veteran journalist Ben Caspit 'the situation is bad. Perhaps very bad.'

'Right now, there is no joint operational contingency plan against Iran should efforts to return to the nuclear agreement fail. And even worse, the Americans do not have any solution whatsoever to such a situation. They do not have a Plan B,' he said after a meeting between Israeli national security adviser Eyal Hulata last week with his American counterpart Jake Sullivan..."

#### US pushing Israel to allow opening of consulate for PA in Jerusalem

October 13, 2021 Arutz Sheva 7 reported: "The Biden administration is pushing Israel to allow it to reopen its consulate for the Palestinian Authority in Jerusalem, a US State Department official told reporters in regards to the meeting between Blinken and Lapid today (Wednesday).

The official pointed out that the US still backs the two-state solution and stresses the importance of preventing violence or unilateral steps.

'The Biden administration began with an outright commitment to a two-state solution and we intend to see this happen. We expect cooperation from both sides: this includes prevention of the annexation of territories, building settlements, destruction of property, incitement to violence, and halting payments to terrorist prisoners,' the senior official said..."

#### North Korea: Kim Jong-un vows to build 'invincible military'

October 12, 2021 bbc.com reported: "North Korea's leader has vowed to build an 'invincible military' in the face of what it says are hostile policies from the United States, state media report.

Kim Jong-un added that weapons development was for self-defense, and not to start a war. Mr. Kim made the comments at a rare defense exhibition while flanked by a variety of large missiles. North Korea has recently tested what it claims to be new hypersonic and anti-aircraft missiles. The South meanwhile has recently tested its own submarine-launched weapon.

In his speech at the Self-Defense 2021 exhibition held in the North's capital, Pyongyang, Mr. Kim addressed the military build-up in the South and said that North Korea did not want to fight its neighbor.

'We are not discussing war with anyone, but rather to prevent war itself and to literally increase war deterrence for the protection of national sovereignty,' he said..."

### PA: Temple Mount belongs only to Muslims

October 12, 2021 Arutz Sheva 7 reported: "Palestinian Authority (PA) cabinet leader Mohammad Shtayyeh on Monday blasted Prime Minister Naftali Bennett, who ruled out the establishment of a Palestinian state for fear of it becoming a state of terror.

Speaking at a cabinet meeting in Ramallah, Shtayyeh said that the Palestinian people are the 'victim' of colonial Israel, they are defending their right and therefore cannot be accused of terrorism.

He stressed that 'the occupying state is committing terrorism against our people that is manifested in taking over the land, killing children, demolishing houses, breaking into places of worship, expelling people from their homes, demolishing their villages and intimidating children. '..."

#### Iran claims to have 80% of uranium needed to build nuclear bomb

October 11, 2021 jpost.com reported: "Iran has enriched more than 120 kg. of 20% enriched uranium, the head of its atomic energy organization, Mohammad Eslami, said Saturday evening, state news agency IRNA reported.

'We have passed 120 kilograms,' IRNA quoted him as saying. 'We have more than that figure.'

'Our people know well that they [Western powers] were meant to give us the enriched fuel at 20% to use in the Tehran reactor, but they haven't done so,' Eslami said. 'If our colleagues do not do it, we would naturally have problems with the lack of fuel for the Tehran reactor.'

If true, the numbers could be considered a major jump forward in uranium enrichment, potentially eventually toward a nuclear weapon if Tehran made the choice to try and break the nuclear threshold..."

# Abbas to Al-Sisi: We're ready to achieve peace with Israel

October 8, 2021 Arutz Sheva 7 reported: "Palestinian Authority (PA) chairman Mahmoud Abbas and Egyptian President Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi held a phone call on Wednesday in which they discussed the readiness to resume peace and achieve calm with Israel, the *Xinhua* news agency reported.

According to the report, Abbas explained to Al-Sisi the Palestinian side's readiness to act under the auspices of the Middle East Quartet, which comprises the United States, Russia, the European Union, and the UN..."
